PhD Program Guidelines for Scholars

Welcome to the PhD Program at Graphic Era (Deemed to be University). This booklet provides a comprehensive overview of the procedures, requirements, and regulations governing a scholar's PhD journey.

Phase I: Registration and Enrollment

The following are the steps for the enrollment into the PhD program.

1. Initial Documentation

- Complete document verification in the Research Department.
- Fill in the form provided by the Research Department.
- Pay all necessary fees in the Accounts Division.
- After submission of the fee receipt, Research Department will complete the enrolment procedure in the PhD program.

2. Supervisor Selection

- After completion of the enrolment procedure in the Research Department, Scholar is required to report to his/her department. The scholar will be guided to the Department by the Research Department of the University.
- Fill out the form (provided by the Research Department) for the selection of a Supervisor and submit it to the Departmental Research Committee (DRC). This exercise will be completed in the Department. The details of the DRC Chairman will be provided by the Research Department.
- DRC will provide the list of eligible Supervisors list alongwith their contact details and area of expertise to the scholar.
- Scholar is required to approach the probable Supervisors and provide list to the DRC. The Department will facilitate the scholar in this process.

3. Student Research Committee Formation

- The DRC will finalize the Supervisor after discussion. After Supervisor is approved by the DRC, the Supervisor will submit a form for the formation of the Student Research Committee (SRC) to the DRC for final approval. This exercise will be completed by the Supervisor and the Department.
- Once SRC is constituted, the process for course work subject selection will be initiated by the Supervisor in consultation with SRC. The scholar will also be invited in the meeting. The subjects for the course work will be decided keeping in view that they are relevant to the area of research of the scholar.
- The SRC shall meet within two weeks of its formation to approve prescribed coursework.
- Simultaneously, scholar is required to discuss his/her probable research area with his/her Supervisor and start reviewing the relevant literature.

Phase II: Coursework Requirements

Coursework is the foundational academic phase of the PhD. The coursework will be conducted by the department.

4. Credit Requirements

The minimum credit requirement for PhD coursework is as follows:

- Minimum 12 credits - This must include a "Research and Publication Ethics" course (as per UGC D.O. No. F.1-1/2018) and a research methodology course.
- Scholars admitted after completion of a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree program require a minimum of 16 credits.
- Scholars can take MOOCs (like SWAYAM, NPTEL) for course work credit. For this purpose, approval of SRC is required.
- For registration of MOOCs, the scholar can consult/discuss with his/her supervisor.

5. Coursework Timeline

- The DRC will notify the class schedule based on the approved subjects for coursework.
- Preferably, the course work should be completed within 6 months in order to complete the Ph.D. in time.
- However, the following additional time can be given to complete the course on the basis of the recommendations of the SRC and DRC:-
- Two semesters for Full-time scholars.
- Three semesters for Part-time scholars.
- Under exceptional circumstances, the Vice Chancellor may grant a single extension of 6 more months based on the recommendations of the DRC and SRC. After this, no further extension will be granted and the enrollment will be cancelled.

7. Coursework Performance

To continue in the program and be eligible to submit the thesis, the scholar must obtain a minimum of 55% of marks or its equivalent grade (e.g., in the UGC 7-point scale) in the each subject of the course work.

Phase III: Research Proposal and Candidature

Successful completion of coursework leads to the formalization of the research topic as per the following:-

8. Proposal Submission

- Upon successful completion of coursework, the scholar become eligible to submit the research proposal.
- The scholar must submit the research proposal on his/her topic within 3 months of coursework completion to SRC.

9. Research Proposal Presentation

The Supervisor will initiate the process of presentation of the research proposal/synopsis to a Panel consisting of:

- Head of the Department/DRC Chairman
- SRC members
- Two professors from allied disciplines (nominated by the Vice Chancellor)
- Two Professors from the department (as research experts from the domain)
- DRC members
- The presentation will be scheduled with at least 10 to 12 days' notice to all members, including the scholar.

10. Proposal Outcome

- The panel will take a decision on the proposal.
- The panel may also suggest changes to the proposal/synopsis and ask the scholar to modify it.
- In case of rejection by the above panel, the scholar will be given six months to submit a new proposal, which will be evaluated again by the same panel.
- If the panel is not satisfied with the performance of the scholar after the second attempt, it may recommend cancellation of the candidature.

11. Post-Approval Requirements

- Upon successful approval of the proposal/synopsis, the scholar must present his/her progress to the SRC at least once in every semester.
- To be eligible for the progress presentation, the scholar is required to complete semester enrollment in December and June of each academic year.

Phase IV: Program Duration and Completion

12. Duration of the Programme

The duration is counted from the date of the admission.

Maternity/Child Care Leave: Female scholars may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave for up to 240 days, once in the entire duration of the PhD.

13. Thesis Submission

- After completion of all the requirements (successful submission of progress reports, paper publication, fee submission, duration, etc.), the scholar may request the SRC for

conduction of pre-PhD. presentation. For any research publication produced during the Ph.D. tenure, the student should be the first author, and the supervisor should be the corresponding author.

- SRC will evaluate the research work and recommend for pre-PhD. presentation.
- After SRC approval, the research work will be evaluated by DRC.
- After DRC approval, the scholar is required to present his/her research work before the Panel which had earlier evaluated the research proposal. This is called pre-PhD. presentation.
- After approval by the Panel, the scholar is required to submit his/her thesis along with synopsis within three months to DRC after plagiarism check. The plagiarism check report from university library should be verified by the scholar and Supervisor.

14. Thesis Evaluation

- The thesis will be sent to two external experts for evaluation.
- After receipt of comments from the experts, the scholar is required to incorporate these comments into his/her thesis.
- After successful incorporation and recommendations from the experts final viva-voce is scheduled wherein the scholar is required to defend his/her thesis.

15. Award of Ph.D. Degree

- After successful defence of the thesis, the scholar is required to submit three bound copies and soft copy of the thesis to the Research Department.
- After this, the thesis will be uploaded on the Shodh Ganga by the Research Department.
- After this, provisional degree certificate is provided to the scholar.
- Final degree is awarded in the Convocation ceremony of the University.

16. Cancellation of Registration

The registration may be automatically cancelled or is liable for administrative cancellation under the following circumstances:

Automatic Cancellation

- Exceeding the maximum period stipulated for the program (i.e., 8 years for standard scholars, 10 years for eligible female/PwD scholars).
- After the expiry of the stipulated period for thesis submission, or after the expiry of the extended period, if a further extension is not obtained.

Administrative Cancellation

- Failure to pay semester fees within the stipulated time.
- Failure to pass the course requirements as per norms (i.e., minimum 55% marks).
- Submission of two consecutive six-month progress reports that are not submitted or are unsatisfactory.
- The SRC/DRC recommends cancellation due to unsatisfactory performance.
- The scholar requests to withdraw from the program.
- Being found guilty of violating rules/regulations or involvement in indiscipline/criminal activity.
