- Under 3+1+1 program, GEU students would pursue 3 years at GEU and will be transferred to partner university for one year, earning the GEU UG degree.
- · Students shall proceed further for Masters from same university. However few credits from masters shall be waived off conseding the creadits from previous year.
- IELTS could be required in some universities. Minimum 6.5 over all score is required. Some of the universities shall waive off.
- · TOEFL could be required in some universities. Minimum of 85 over all score is required. Some of the universities shall waive off.
- Insurance shall differ country to country. Some of the universities might charge miscellanous fees towards books, materials, supplies, etc.
- The eligibility criteria for partner universities may change from time to time. Students are advised to check the partner university's website for the latest entry requirements for eligible program.
- The approximate fees mentioned above is for AY 2025-26 and is likely to be revised next year.
- Students shall be eligible to apply for post study VISA/OPT/ Work permit after completion of Masters be issued as per the country norms.
