COMMUNICATION

MANDATORY Exam Day Readiness Check

Complete the **mandatory Exam Day Readiness Check** once the details are shared via email, prior to the examination date.

This readiness check is conducted to help you test system compatibility, camera and microphone functionality, internet stability, and become familiar with portal navigation — *while also giving you the opportunity to identify and resolve any technical issues in advance.*

On the actual examination day, due to the limited time window and high candidate volume, technical issues **may not be resolvable**. Failure to prepare in advance may adversely affect your performance and, consequently, your scholarship eligibility.

During the readiness process, ensure that you are comfortable utilizing your **mobile phone as a secondary camera** to display your surrounding examination environment, as proctors may require you to do so. Familiarity with this process is essential prior to the main examination.

DEVICE & ENVIRONMENT

The examination must be taken on a **laptop or desktop computer only**. Mobile phones and tablets cannot be used to take the examination.

Ensure:

- Functional webcam and microphone
 - Stable internet connection
 - Adequate power backup
 - Quiet, well-lit room
 - Valid government-issued photo ID ready

The University and/or examination vendor shall not be responsible for technical or environmental disruptions at the candidate's end. Requests for rescheduling due to such issues will not be entertained.

EXAMINATION DAY

Log in at least **30 minutes prior to the commencement of the examination**. Complete all identity verification procedures.

Strictly follow the instructions of the proctor promptly at all times. Failure to comply may result in termination from the examination.
